Online Registration is now open on the Dinwiddie County Public Schools Website www.dinwiddie.k 12.va.us

Rising Kindergartners complete the Registration K-12 form online.

Must be 5 years old <u>on or before September 30, 2021</u>

Preschoolers complete the Preschool Joint Application form online.

Must be 3 or 4 years old on or before September 30, 2021

What happens after I complete the online form?

You will be contacted by the school's Registrar to schedule an appointment to complete registration.

What do I need to bring with me to my scheduled appointment?

- Valid photo ID (Parent/Legal Guardian)
- Child's Original Birth Certificate
- Child's School Entrance Health form with up-to-date Immunizations
- Proof of Residency:
 - Deed, Lease or Mortgage statement
 - Current utility bill (water, electricity, gas)
 - Two additional legal documents with current address
 - Proof of Residency Form (if the parent/legal guardian(s) name is not on the lease, mortgage statement or deed)
- Income Verification (Preschool ONLY: W-2, 1040, 3 Consecutive Check stubs, TANF or SSI statement)
- Custody papers (if applicable)
