Elaborative – embellishes or expands upon ideas, questions, or solutions.					
Imaginative – may be intuitive about something that has never happened to him/her; may be challenged by and appreciate complex or intricate problems or ideas.					
Artistic – may show exceptional abilities in visual or performing arts.					
Fluent – generates many responses to a given idea; suggests several directions and exhibits departures from the mainstream of thought in a classroom setting.					
Focused – may be reluctant to move from one subject area to another.					
Sensitive – has an advanced sense of justice, fairness, and global awareness.
